

Exporters Set to Get Fresh Sops for Laggard Sectors

The government has decided to come to the aid of select export sectors that are yet to recover from the global meltdown by offering new incentives and expanding the scope of existing packages. Exports broke a 13-month fall in November 2009, growing 18% to touch \$ 13.2 billion, but a commerce department study found that sectors such as engineering, handicraft, textile, pharmaceuticals and leather are still under the weather.
