

IMF Chief says Global economic recovery likely in 2010

Dominique Strauss-Kahn, Chief of IMF announced during his visit to the State of Tajikistan, that while 2009 was likely to continue to bring difficulties, negative global financial trends should begin to reverse by 2010. Strauss-Kahn made these comments to reporters after meeting with Tajik President Emomali Rakhmon as part of an ongoing tour of Central Asian states, many of which have been badly affected by the global financial downturn.
